

PEN-F Rear Grip Replacement Instructions

Preparation-

- 1) Remove the rear rubber grip from the back of the camera. It may already be off...
- 2) Completely remove all the tape/glue that is sticking to the grip area of the camera. Use tweezers if necessary. **Do not use any liquid to remove the tape.**
- 3) Make sure the area is 100% clean, or the new grip may not adhere properly.
- 4) Remove the new tape/glue from the yellow paper (Part #WC858700) with tweezers.

Installation-

- 5) Align the tape/glue to the grip location. Once in place press down with your finger.
- 6) Using the flat side of the tweezers, rub the white area of the tape, while applying pressure, to ensure its sticking to the camera. Be sure to rub the corners.
- 7) Carefully remove the white paper. Be careful not to pull up the new tape/glue.
- 8) Align the rear rubber grip (Part #WC858600) to the body and press firmly over the entire area with your finger.

Note: *Be sure to use the tape/glue (Part #WC858700) from Olympus. Using another type of glue could cause damage to the camera and/or the surrounding parts. It may also void your warranty.

*Do not use the old thumb grip as most likely it has been stretched and will no longer fit the area it was designed for.

*The procedure described above shall be performed at your own risk. By performing, or attempting to perform, the procedure described above, you hereby waive and release Olympus from any damage, defect, aesthetically displeasing display, or failure that could result from the performance of, or attempt to perform, such procedure.

If you are not handy or confident that you can perform the above procedure, you can always send your camera to Olympus for a new rear grip.
